ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE NEWS

“IMPORTANT – Dangerous Hazards!

Hi folks, as you have probably heard by now, we had a double house fire here in our Villages last month. What you probably didn't know is that there was a casualty. A lady from across the street, a hero, tried to wake up the folks in a third house to warn them of the danger. She ran to the side of the house to beat on the windows, but she tripped over a rain drainage pipe, fell and broke her arm.

Why am I telling you this? Because, it is important for everyone to realize the importance of following the Architectural Rules and the CC&Rs. As I walk my dog around the Villages, I notice many places where the rain drainage pipes are laying on top of the ground to carry rain water to the street. The rules state that they are to be buried (if they are covered over with gravel that is acceptable). See “Rain Gutters/Drainage” on p.11 of the “*Architectural Rules & Regulations*”, which states, “When topography permits, all downspouts must drain to the street through underground lines or lined drainage channel.” That hero lady (above) could have been hurt much worse. Or, it could have been a fireman that got hurt while trying to put out the blazing houses!

There are rules for living in a Retirement Community, and most are for safety, even though we might not see the reason for them. The rule on covering on-ground pipes is often scoffed at by home-owners, as a silly expense. While it is true that aesthetically the pipes look much better when buried, they need to be buried to prevent a tripping and injury hazard.

Please, check your rain drainage pipes that may be on the ground, and ***make sure that they are buried.*** It's in our Rules for a reason.

The Sunshine Club



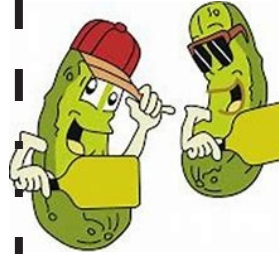
The Sunshine group is here to help. We hope you will keep us informed of anyone who is ill, hurt, had a death or just needs help.

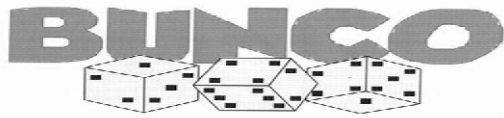

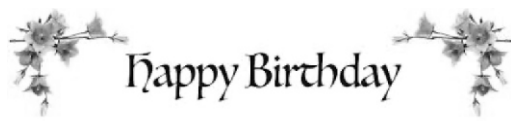

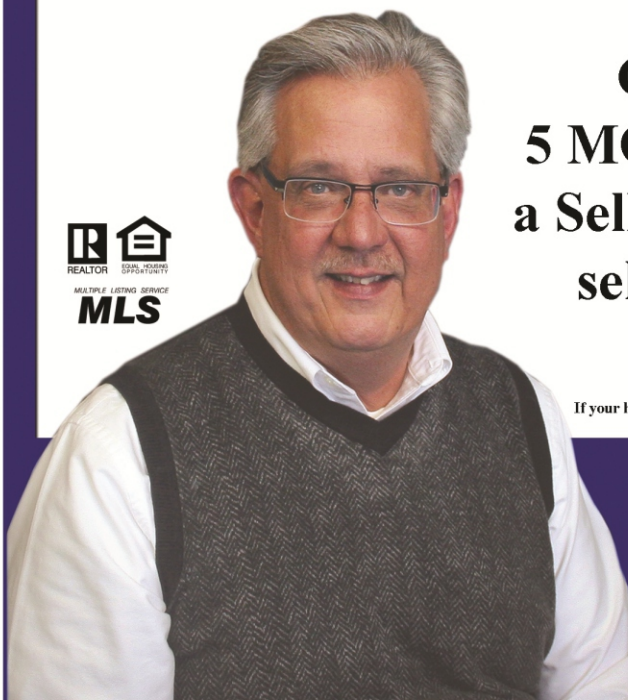
