Architectural Committee News

“When & Why Do I Need To Turn In a ‘Request For Change’ ”

Hi Folks,

With spring and summer just around the corner many of us are thinking about remodeling, upgrading, and fixing up our homes. We live in a beautiful place called the Villages at Lynx Creek, and we want to keep it looking beautiful and peaceful. In order to help all of us to do our best at this, the HOA has established the *Architectural Committee* for the purpose of guiding us so that we get the results that we want.

This question (in the title) comes up quite a bit. The simple answer is this: **Whenever you make any kind of change** to your lot or the outside of your house *that changes the looks of your property*, you must register a simple form called, “*Request For Change*” (otherwise known as RFC). Now, there are some exceptions, which are laid out in the “**Architectural Rules & Regulations**” and in the **CC&Rs** (you should have a copy of both of these documents, if not pick one up at the office).

The purpose is stated in the ***Architectural Rules & Regulations***, page1, as follows:

“The purpose of these Rules is to insure that our community remains a pleasant place in which to live and that all homeowners benefit from these construction standards which will enhance our home appearances and maintain our property values.”

“It is the responsibility of the lot owner to make a formal “*Request for Change*” on the proper forms, provided by the Villages office, to the Architectural Committee before placing any “improvements” on their lot or making any “external alterations”...”

Your Architectural Committee is comprised of fellow home-owners who also love living at the Villages at Lynx Creek, and want to help our neighbors continue enjoying their properties as well.

The committee members are: Chairman/Board member Al Myers, Vice Chairman Bill Johnson, and members Nancy Larson, Carl Shulak, John Black, Sylvia Cortez, and Rick Merrell.

PROPER USE OF TRASH COMPACTOR

(THE BUTTON IS THE KEY ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE DOOR. IT SHOULD NOT BE TAKEN OUT OR TURNED).
3. THE VILLAGES MUST PAY TO REPAIR THE COMPACTOR WHEN IT IS DAMAGED BY MIS-USE.
