

Notes from the Board

The next HOA meeting will be on Thursday, March 17, in the Social Hall at 2:30 p.m. There will be a status update of outstanding projects and some new business items to discuss.

At this meeting, the board will authorize a Nominating Committee and appoint a current board member to chair this committee, in addition to two homeowners who will assist. Also needed will be volunteers to prepare ballot packets for pick-up or mailing out and then count the returned ballots. Please consider volunteering and let the office staff know if you are interested in helping out with this important function.

This year, the election will be held to fill two positions on the board. The terms for Rich Mann and MaryAnn Schulte will expire in July.

The election determines the two candidates who receive the most votes – they will serve on the board for a two-year term. Candidates are not running for a specific officer role, only to fill a position as a board member. After the annual meeting in July, the board members vote among themselves to determine who will serve as President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Director-at-Large for the upcoming year.

To be eligible as a candidate for the board according to our Bylaws, a person must be an owner in good standing for not less than twelve months immediately preceding the close of the application period, and must be in physical residence not less than six months of the twelve months preceding the close of the application period. Previous interrupted ownership and/or residency or rental shall not apply toward this requirement. An announcement will be made when candidate applications are available, usually around April 1.

The phrase "in good standing" means that the owner is not more than thirty days in arrears in their monthly assessment and has not had their HOA membership suspended.

The Bylaws more completely list the powers and duties of the board (Article VIII on pages 6 and 7), and also the duties of each officer position (Article IX on pages 7-8-9). Please review and consider running for the board.

If you are aware of anything in the common area that needs repair or replacement, please bring it to our attention by contacting the office or any of the board members. We rely on residents to notice things that we may not see, and we thank you for that.
