MANAGER'S REPORT

November 2022 to January 2023

Accomplishments:

FINANCE

- I met each month with the Finance Committee to overview the financials.
- I worked with the Board of Directors and the Budget Committee to finalize the Capital Expenditures and Operating Budgets for 2023.

MAINTENANCE

- Created a new procedure for water leaks and other maintenance emergencies in the evenings or on the weekends and holidays.
- The maintenance crew and I have a schedule for special projects. Rich schedules out two months in advance based upon weather and immediacy. Rich and Joe have completed the following projects:
 1. Installed a skid prevention grid in front of the compactor stairs
 2. Replaced the Clothesline
 3. Supervised the maintenance and repair of the water machine
 4. Cleaned out all of the gutters in the Common Area
 5. Repaired the maintenance tool shed
 6. Replaced all of the air filters in the Common Area and created a maintenance schedule so that the filters will be replaced on a rotating basis
 7. Supervised the water leaks over the New Year's weekend to assure that flooding onto neighboring lots did not occur
 8. Along with regular maintenance of the pool and spa and common area, completed approximately 50 work orders.
