The residents asked if he would return this summer in the afternoon. The Villages is in Prescott Valley and there is obviously change happening that impacts our community. At his last meeting he addressed growth surrounding the Villages including water, lack of grocery stores, access to Highway 69 and more. He is willing to update information from that meeting and discuss other issues.

Annual Manager's Report JUNE 2021 – JUNE 2022

FINANCE

- I meet each month with the Finance Committee to overview Worked with the Board of Directors and the Budget Committee to finalize the Capital Expenditures and Operating Budgets for 2022. We created an Investment Statement Policy to be reviewed by the Board and distributed to the Association owners and residents.
- I worked with Bob Loskill who volunteered to serve as the advisor to the Board on the Investment Committee. Bob and I met with Wells Fargo Advisors to investigate a brokerage account and investigate investing in Certificates of Deposit for any funds that are above the needs for Capital Improvements or Operating Expenses. The CD's will have 1-, 3-, and 5-year maturities.
- The Treasurer and I met with Wells Fargo Small Business Cash Management and received a proposal for Wells Fargo to provide Small Business services to The Villages. This would mean transferring the bulk of the reserve funds to Wells Fargo.

MAINTENANCE

- We created a new procedure for water leaks in the evenings or on the weekends and holidays to be distributed to the Association owners and residents.
- Updated space signage in South Storage Lot and auditing storage spaces for correct tenants.
- The maintenance crew and I have schedule for special projects which include complete aerating and thatching of the dog park grass and all of the grass in the common areas, restriping of all of the yellow and red curbs, fencing upgrade for the former horseshoe pit and plans to move the horseshoe pit inside the pool area, stripping and replanting of the plant beds outside of the Association Office, inspecting the monuments at the entrance to The Villages and repair and repainting.
- Dan also completed the classes to become a Certified Pool Operator.
- The red curbs have been painted. The common area lawns have been redone.
- The replanting of the plant beds outside of the Association Office is complete, except for one tree that is on order.
- Asphalt repair was needed on the Southwest side of the parking lot by the mailboxes. This is completed and the asphalt will be restriped and the yellow stripping will be completed.
- The contract for the new fencing for the new dog play area will begin soon.
- The following projects are still on the schedule: plans to move the horseshoe pit inside the pool area. and trimming of Association trees.
- Created a policy for Compactor use by residents and resident landscapers to be approved by The Board and distributed to the Association owners and residents.

OFFICE

- Created evaluation forms for employees and began the performance evaluation process. Reviewed performance with staff members.
- Assisted in installing new badge printer and programs for new badge system.
- Continue to work with the Architectural Committee regarding grievances and enforcement of CC&R's, and other rules and regulations.
- We are still working with staff on written procedures for daily, weekly, monthly, and yearly planning of projects and maintenance. Dan prepared a daily, weekly, monthly, and seasonal task list and created a pool maintenance step by step procedure.
- Jeanine is participating in Continuing Education Classes online. I am participating my Arizona Association of Community Managers classes.
- Worked with members of the Board to refine written procedures for office positions.
- Many thanks to Joyce Pinckney for writing a complete step by step instruction manual for the front desk volunteers.
- The key system has been implemented and all residents who have requested key cards have been accommodated.

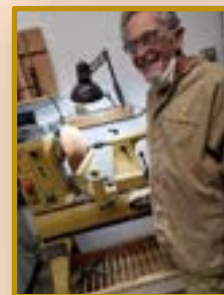

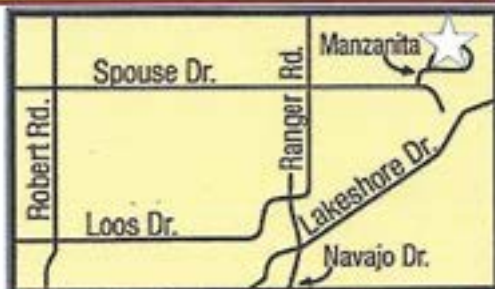

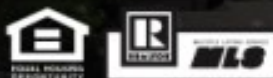
