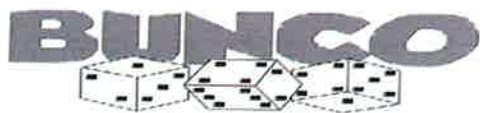

Please remember to **plan ahead and to submit a Request For Change (a, k. a., an RFC)** to the Architectural Committee for planned changes to the outside of your home or to the lot. The “Rule of Thumb” is that “anything that changes the looks of the outside of your home needs an RFC”. The RFC may be picked up at the Villages’ Office.

Starting **January 15, 2020**, we will be meeting on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month. The RFC needs to be **turned in by the Friday BEFORE the 1st or 3rd Wednesday**. At the Wednesday meeting you will receive the Villages’ yellow permit, which will need to be displayed so as to be seen from the street during your project. When the project is finished, please sign the back of the Permit and turn it in to the office.

Our intent is to help you to accomplish your outside home improvements in a manner that is in keeping with the “**CC&Rs**” and the “**Architectural Rules & Regulations**”. We all want our properties to maintain or improve our property values as well as the beauty of our community.
