

App Store icon for iPad or iPhone



Types of Apps

Native apps - for a single mobile operating system;

- for a particular platform or device,
- apps built for systems like:
 - iOS, Android, Windows phone, Blackberry.
- can not be used on a platform other than their own.
- win the speed competition.
- easy user interface.
- can use the camera, the GPS, the accelerometer, the compass, the list of contacts, etc.
- can use gestures and notifications.
 - Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Pokémon Go.


Types of Apps

- Hybrid apps built using multi-platform web technologies;
 - mainly website applications disguised in a native wrapper,
 - single code base for all platforms,
 - inability to look exactly same way on two or more different platforms,
 - allow cross platform development and reduce development costs,
 - all the pages are the same,
 - except for the top header,
 - which is platform specific.
 - are part native apps, part web apps.
 - Walgreens, Banana Republic, Instagram, Twitter, UBER, Gmail.

Types of Apps


- **Web apps** software applications that behave in a fashion similar to native applications.
 - must use a browser to run,
 - require minimum of device memory,
 - users can get access from any device whenever there is internet connection.
 - Web apps win the prize on discoverability.
 - available GPS, the tap-to-call feature.
 - Financial Times, Google Docs, Starbucks, Evernote, AliExpress.

Categories of Apps



The App Store is Shrinking \ On Purpose

- From 2017 to 2020, the number of iPhone apps in the App Store declined.
 - Apple introduced new standards to improve the quality of the apps available in the store.
 - Apple also removed old apps that are:
 - no longer compatible with new versions of the iOS,
 - apps that copy other apps,
 - apps that provide tools that aren't needed on the iPhone, like antivirus.
- Number of Apps available to iPads is complex because of:
 - iPadOS apps
 - iPad apps.





Last Time it was used date




How to Delete Apps

- Users delete Apps
 - to free up storage space
 - no longer using these Apps.
- Be aware that there are certain stock Apps which cannot be deleted.
 - Stock Apps like: Safari, App Store, Photos, Camera, Settings, Messages, Wallet and Find My
 - Calculator, Calendar, Compass, Contacts, FaceTime, iTunes Store, Mail, Maps, Music, News, Notes, Stocks, Reminders, Weather, Voice Memos, Podcasts, Tips and TV can be deleted.
- Also delete any "third party" Apps installed on the device.

Delete Apps From Home Screen.


- 1. On the Home screen, locate the App that you want to delete.
- 2. Tap and hold on the App icon.
- 3. Tap 'Delete App' option in the pop-up menu.
- 4. On the confirmation pop-up, tap 'Delete App' to confirm.



Delete Apps on iDevice


Delete icon Apps Display

Delete Multiple Apps


- 1. Tap and hold on any App icon on the Home screen.
- 2. In the pop-up menu, tap on Edit Home Screen option.
- 3. To delete any App, tap on the "x" icon next to the App.
- 4. On the confirmation pop-up, tap on the 'Delete option' to confirm.



Delete Apps Using Settings

Look at the amount of storage space taken up by the Apps before delete or offload.

- 1. Settings > General > tap iDevice Storage.
 - A. The list will take time to populate.
 - B. The first app listed will be taking up the most storage space.
- 2. Tap on the App that you want to delete from the list.
- 3. On App Details screen, tap on 'Delete App'.
- Repeat the above steps to delete other unnecessary apps that are taking up storage space on the device.
- Note: note the difference between 'Offload App' and 'Delete App.'




Prevent Apps From Being Deleted


Follow the steps below to prevent apps from being deleted.


1. Settings > Screen Time > Content & Privacy Restrictions.


Note: On the Content & Settings Restrictions screen, make sure the option for Content & Privacy Restrictions is toggled **ON**.

- 2. Tap 'iTunes & App Store Purchases'.
- 3. On the next screen, tap on 'Deleting Apps'.
- 4. On the next screen, tap on 'Don't Allow'.
 - a. to prevent deleting of Apps on the device.
- Anyone else with access to the device won't be able to delete Apps.









Prevent Apps From Being Deleted

The Final Step
Tap to select an option.

Confirm That Apps Cannot Be Deleted

- 1. From the home screen, tap and hold on any app icon until it starts to Wiggle.
- 2. Since Deleting of the Apps has been disabled, you will not be able to see "X" symbol next to Apps on the iPhone.


Note: In normal settings, tapping and holding on any of the App icons causes an "X" sign to appear at the top left corner of the App icons, allowing delete of Apps by tapping on the X symbol.

- This confirms that anyone that has access to the device won't be able to delete Apps,
 - without knowing the restrictions passcode.

How to Recover Deleted Apps

To recover and reinstall deleted Apps at any time.

- 1. Open the 'App Store' on the device.
- 2. Tap on the Profile Picture icon.
 - a) (located at the top-right corner of the screen.)
- 3. On the Account screen, tap 'Purchased'.
- 4. On the next screen, tap 'My Purchases'.
 - A. This will bring up all the Apps on the device.
- 5. Tap on the Cloud icon next to the App that you want to Reinstall.




