





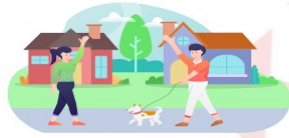

## **2024 BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION SCHEDULE**

**April 1** Candidate Applications will be available at the HOA office. If you would like an application to be emailed to you, please contact Marty or Gail at 928-772-7047 or [thevillagesfinance@gmail.com](mailto:thevillagesfinance@gmail.com). (See below for Candidate Eligibility.)

**May 10** Deadline (Close of the Application Period) to return completed Candidate Applications to the HOA office and give them to a member of the office staff during their normal business hours. Eligible candidate names and resumes will be published in the June Crier.

**May 16** The Nominating Committee will host a "Meet the Candidates" forum, so that residents may ask questions directly to the candidates. This will follow the HOA meeting.

**May 20-June 18** Voting ballots are available at the HOA office during regular business hours for owners to pick up in person. You must wear your card key or show other identification indicating your lot number – only one ballot per lot. You may not obtain the ballot for any other homeowner. Please read and follow the instructions included with your ballot, so that your ballot will not be disqualified. After completing your ballot, you may return it to the HOA office in person or send it via regular mail. We urge you to pick up your ballot and return it in person, to save on mailing expenses, and to assure that it is received by the deadline.

**June 19** The notice of the 2024 Annual Meeting and any remaining ballots not picked up in person will be mailed out to owners at their address of record. Make sure that our HOA records include your correct mailing address for you to receive your ballot in a timely manner.

**July 10** The Annual Meeting will begin at 2:00 p.m. Ballots received at the HOA office on or before 11:00 a.m. will be counted beginning at 11:30 a.m. until completed by the ballot-counting team of volunteers. Meeting attendees will have an opportunity to submit their ballot if they have not already done so. The results of the election will be announced at this meeting.

**CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY** Per The Villages at Lynx Creek Owners Association Bylaws, Article VI, Section 2: "To be eligible as a candidate, a person must be an Owner in good standing for not less than twelve (12) months immediately preceding the close of the application period. Previous interrupted Ownership and/or residency or rental shall not apply toward this requirement." The phrase "in good standing" means that the owner is not more than thirty days in arrears in their monthly assessment and has not had their HOA membership suspended.

# MANAGER'S REPORT

## MANAGER'S REPORT - JUNE

Rich reported on the projects the maintenance staff have completed and have coming up: Social Hall: ballasts in men's and ladies' rooms, new a/c unit above the stage, handrails on the stage steps and new bulletin boards near the entrances. The south storage has had a major overhaul with new sprinkler lines for the photinias, and all the leaves have been cleaned up and out from under the bushes. Rich has gator patched holes near 126 to 133, 125 and 76 and patches on Stonehenge, Peppertree and Obsidian. Tennis court: reinstalled sunscreen and resurfaced the tennis and pickleball courts. Hummingbird Park: Installed veteran's honorary bricks. Moved stop light at 432 for visibility. To do: Move TV into activity room, Assemble and install the new water fountain in pool area, install new handicap steps in pool and repair the pool deck (minor cracks), Install plants in planters in pool area with new drip lines

The new merchant services system is now in place. If you want to use autopay through your checking account, call the office.

There is now a Paint Committee under the Architectural Committee which will simplify the paint selection process for outside painting of your property.

The bylaws revised from the attorney are now ready for review and the Board is asking for a group to compare the old with the new. Please call the office if you can serve. Marty Mann, the Community Coordinator, will be working with the Recreation Committee to coordinate reporting of events and activities in the Crier and will be attending their meeting to help interface with the Association office.

David Wong has volunteered to join the Finance Committee that meets and reviews the financials each month. The Committee consists of Lonnie Fay, Sandy Robbins, and David Wong.
